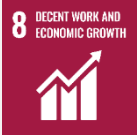

$$17 + A + B + C$$

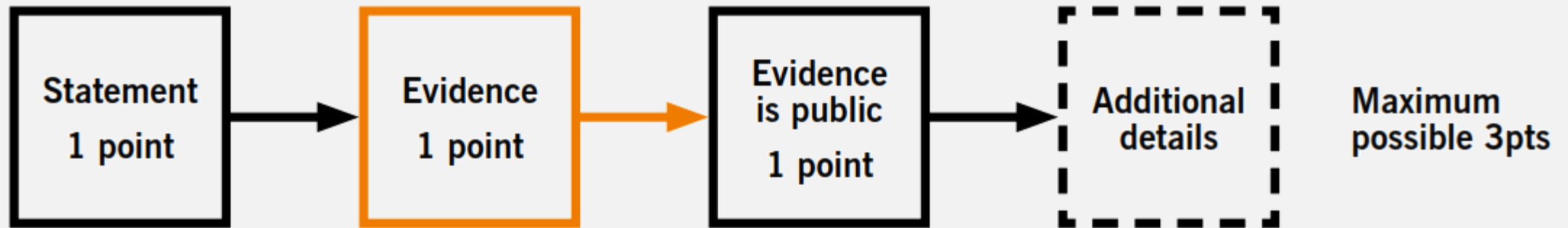

- **Four broad areas:**
 1. Research
 2. Stewardship (supervising or taking care of something)
 3. Outreach
 4. Teaching









Series of questions are asked, and points are assigned according to the answer.

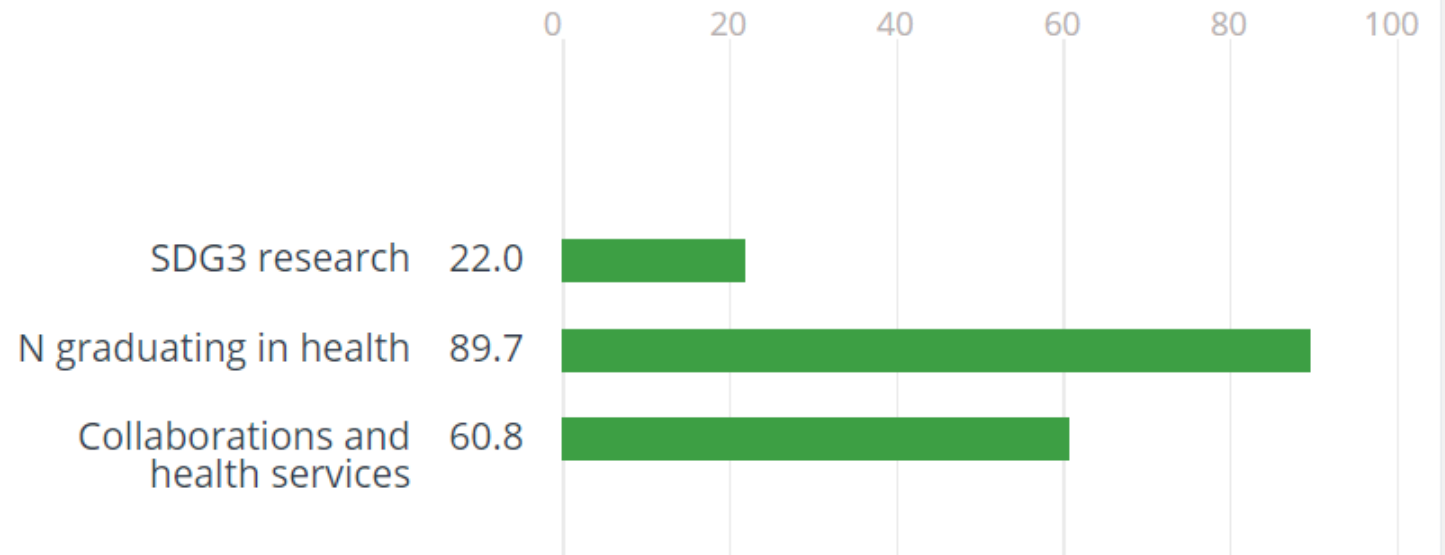

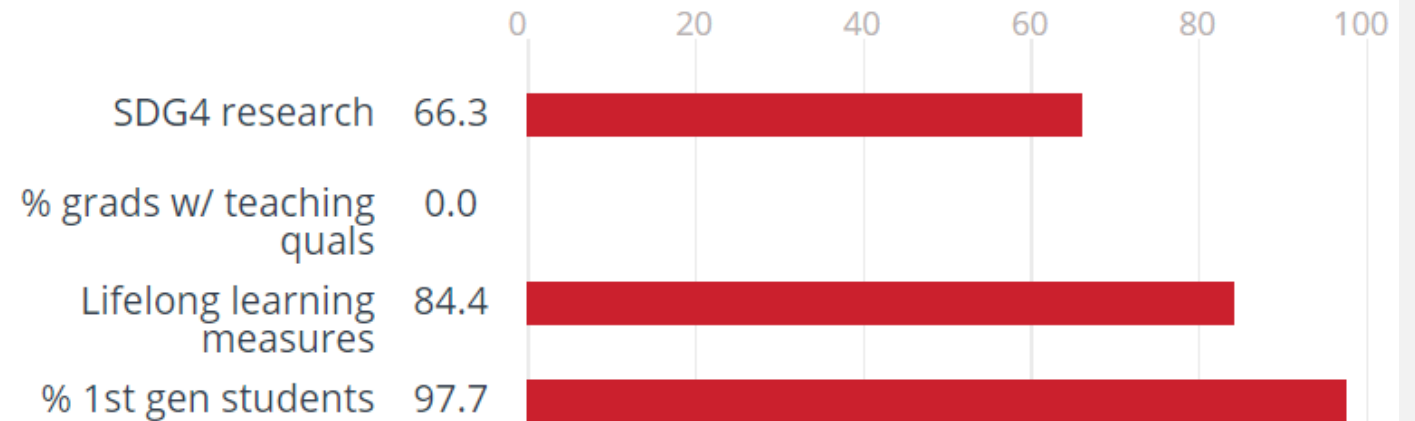

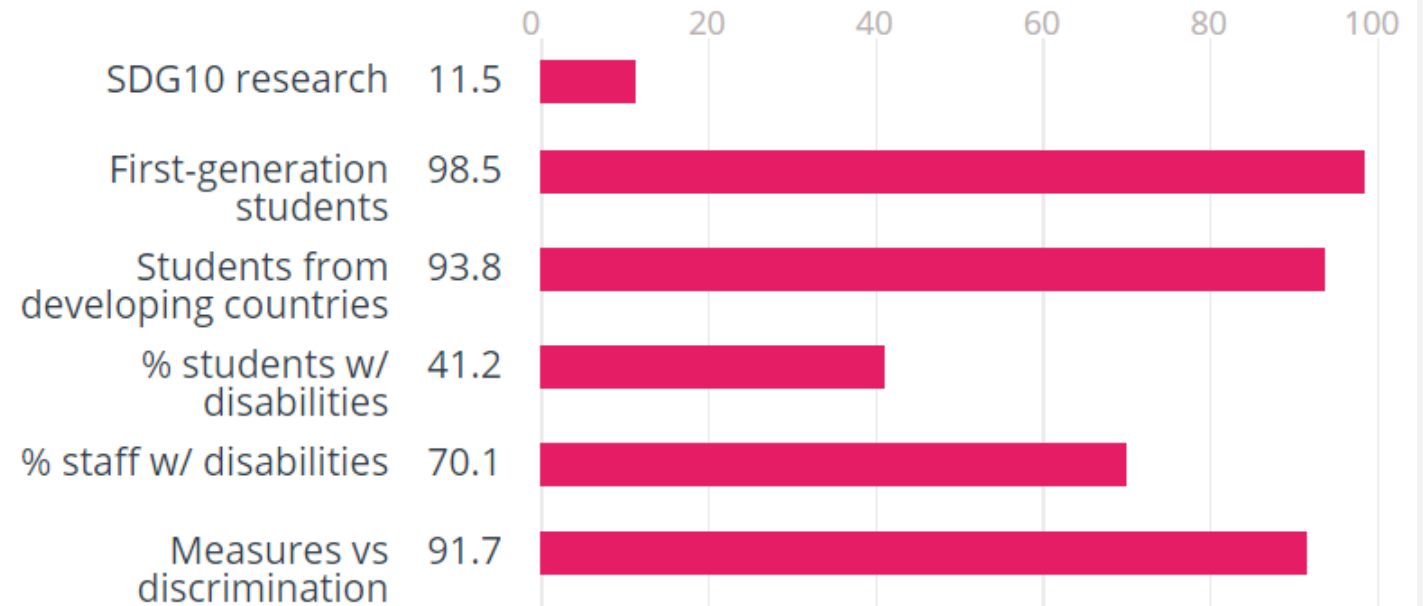

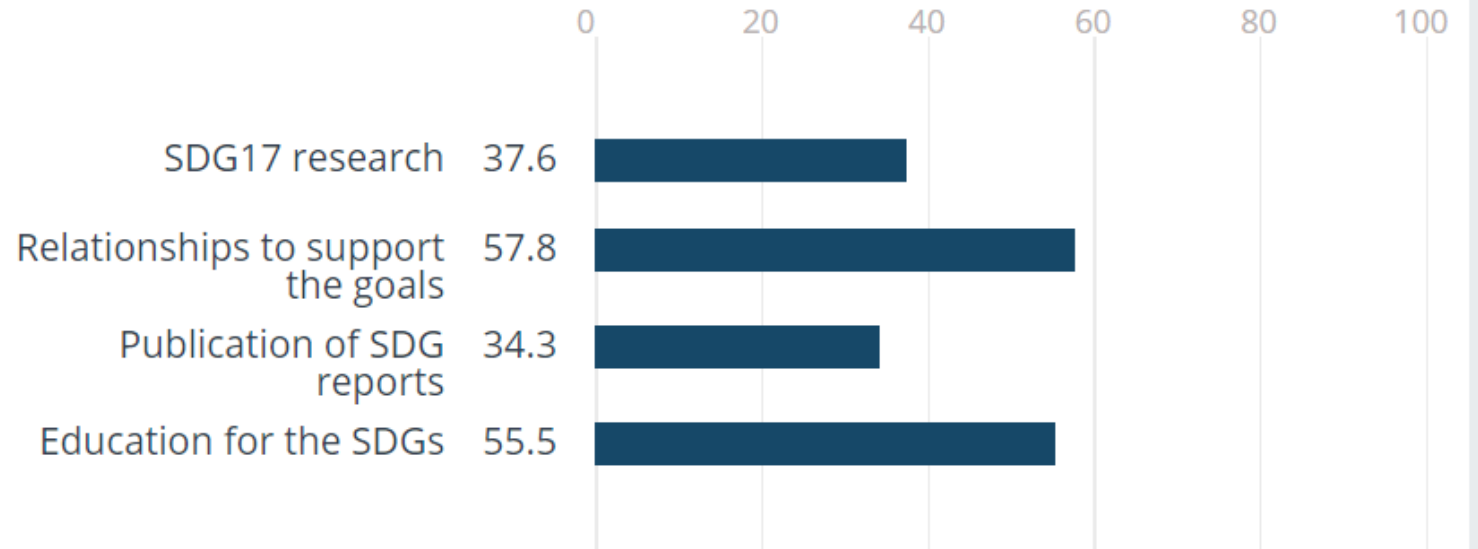

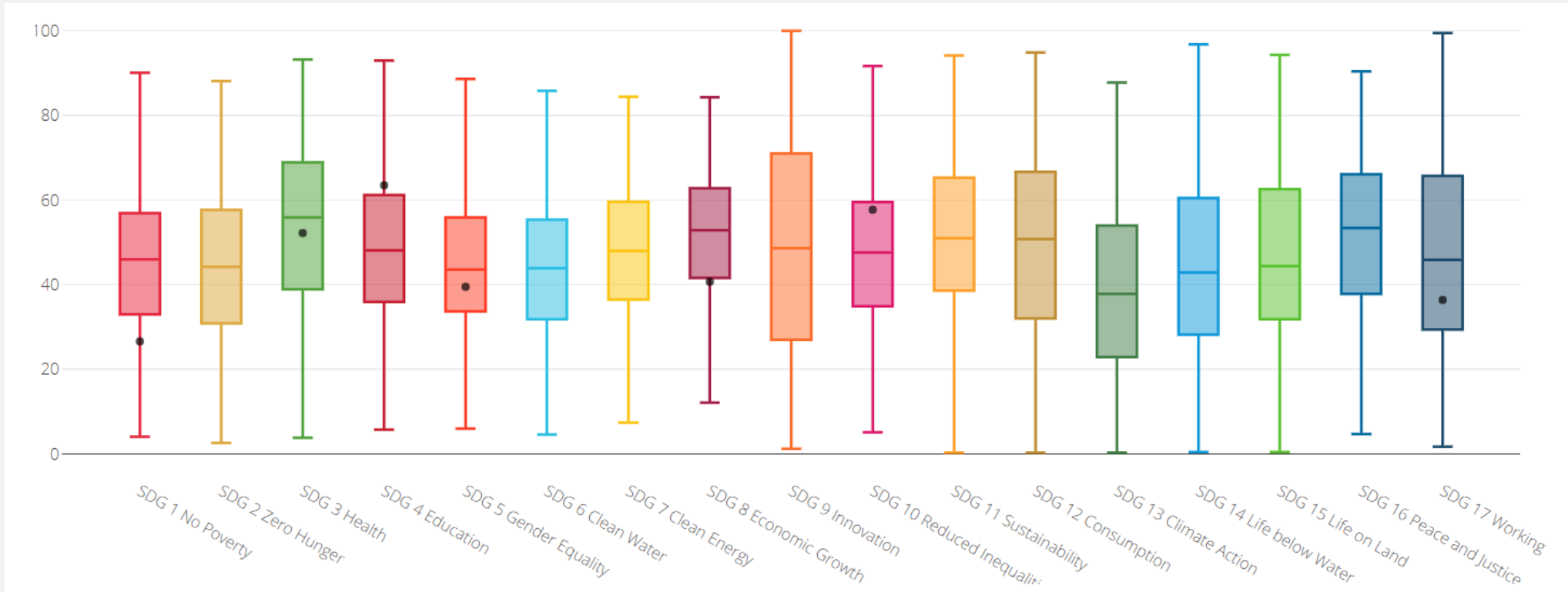

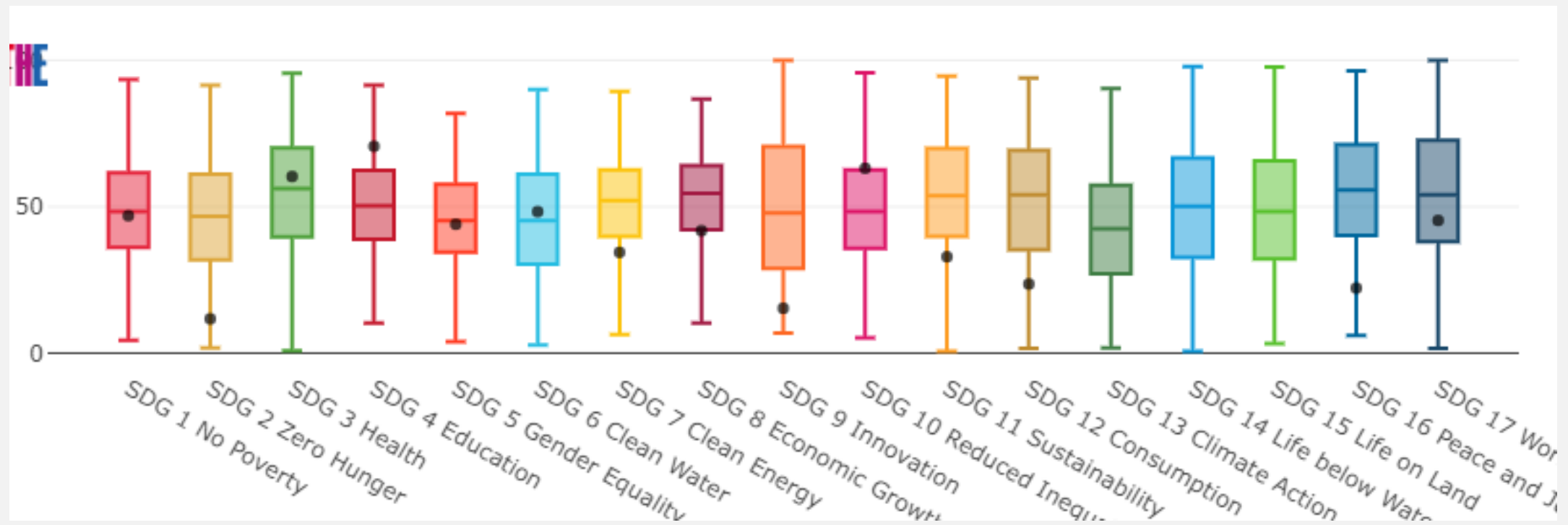
